Alliteration (Sun, sand and surfing) Imperative verbs (bossy verbs: go, take, get)Imagine you visit an amazing hotel. Write a postcard or email to your friend telling them about how wonderful it is.Make a list of all the things you would like to do in the summer holidays. Be as adventurous as you can.
