Welcome Back

As we start the 2021-2022 academic year, we would like to extend a warm welcome to all of our pupils, particularly those who are new to the school in Nursery, Reception and our new starters in other year groups.

As we begin the school year, we would like to thank parents and carers for the continued support given to our pupils throughout their time at Lingfield. We are delighted to be able to start the new school year under more normal circumstances.

As a school we are very much looking forward to a much less disrupted school year. That being said, we have plans in place in the event of any changes made at a local or a national level.

We are particularly looking forward to welcoming parents back into school. We have set provisional dates for Christmas events which I will share with you below. These will include a Christmas Fair and also Christmas performances which have been greatly missed.

School Meals

The price of a school meal is £2.10 per day, please note that all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and year 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the Universal Free School Meal initiative. Pupils from Year 3 onwards need to pay for meals.

Next week we are re-introducing our salad bar at lunchtime to provide a cold alternative to the hot meals on offer. Unlike previously, all food on the salad bar will be served by the lunchtime staff. We know pupils have missed the salad bar option during Covid.

If you meet the criteria below, your child will be entitled to a free school meal and school will also receive additional funding. Please see Mrs Martin in the school office and please be assured that this matter is treated with the upmost confidentiality.

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Shortly we will be sending out a number of forms which we would really appreciate you completing. We will be sending out the personal information forms for you to make any amendments, the photographic permissions form, the loco parentis form and the home school agreement. It is really important that the information we have in school is as up to date as possible, particularly contact information for parents.
