Leave of Absence Requests Reminder

We are receiving a number of leave of absence requests from families wishing to go on holiday. Please can all requests be submitted to school no later than four weeks before the leave is required, this then allows school to follow the correct procedures. Each request is considered on its own merit, however, as Head I can only authorise an absence which falls under being 'an exceptional circumstance.'

An Exceptional Circumstance typically falls within one for the categories below,

- If a parent is service personnel and is returning from a tour of duty abroad where it is evidenced the individual will not be in receipt of any leave in the near future that coincides with school holidays.
- Where an absence from school is recommended by a health professional as part of a parent or child's rehabilitation from a medical or emotional issue.
- The death or terminal illness of a close relative.
- Out of school programmes such as music, arts or sport operating at a high standard of achievement. Documentary evidence of this event will be required.
- Religious observance The Education Act 1996 S444(3) (c), states "on any day exclusively set apart for religious observance by the religious body to which his/her parent belongs".
- To attend a wedding or funeral of a close relative, please note, authorising attendance at weddings does not necessarily include attending weddings abroad which involve extended periods of time away absent from school.
