School Meals

For quite some time now children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 have been entitled to a free school meal as part of the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meal Scheme. As the Year Two children move into Year 3, this entitlement stops and parents will need to pay for a school meal for their child. Next year we have been notified that the price of a school meal will be £2.15.

Under certain circumstances, children may still be entitled to a free school meal. We have a brilliant piece of software which will carry out the check for you on your behalf, all you need to do is enter some details on the website below. 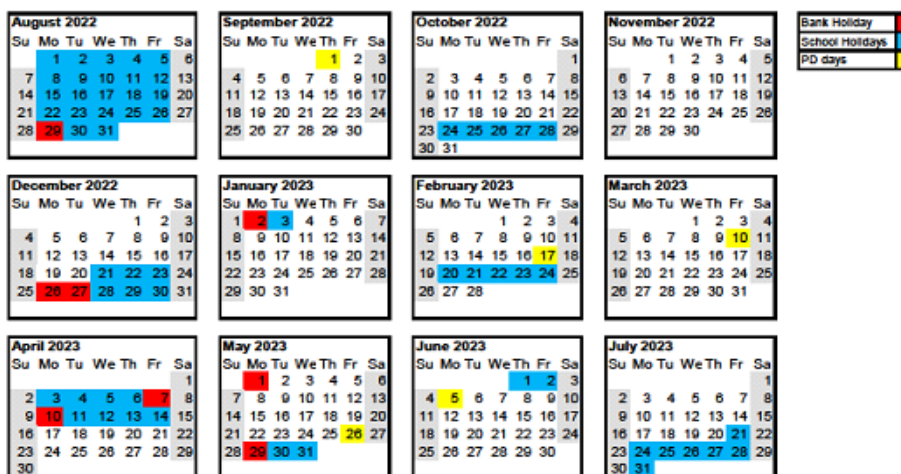
Thank you
