A reminder that World Book Day is on Thursday 2nd March this year. As a school we have lots of reading activities planned for the day and beyond.

- The Friends of Lingfield have organised a book sale with a twist for World Book Day. After school at 3.15pm, on Thursday 2nd March, everyone can head to the hall (via the playground entrance at the back of school) to choose a surprise story. Donated books have all been wrapped up with only a little indication on the front of what kind of book the package contains to add to the fun, surprise element! We are suggesting a minimum donation of £1 per wrapped book package. For children in morning nursery who may miss the sale at the end of the day, Mrs Stoddart will also have some books available.
- Staff are busy recording Masked Reader videos for children to guess who the reader is.
- Our friends at Drake Bookshop have organised online 'Meet the Author' events, these will take place later in March.
- World Book Day tokens have been handed out to pupils this week. The tokens are valid from today (Thursday 16th February). This will give parents and children the opportunity to use the tokens over half term as local bookshops and supermarkets start to get the titles in store. The tokens allow for one FREE book chosen from a special selection or £1 off another title costing over £2.99. Full details are on the tokens.
- Finally, as is tradition at Lingfield, children are welcome to dress up as their favourite book character if they so wish. This is purely optional but we know it is something pupils enjoy doing.
